

SAP Appeal – Academic Success Plan

Before you enroll, you must work with your Student Success Coach to discuss registration and an Academic Success Plan to achieve a 2.0 GPA. You need to pass all courses with at least a C+ or higher and cannot withdraw from any courses, or you risk losing financial aid.

- Use Kraft Center for Student Success or meet with professors at any point you receive assignments or test grades below a C
- Regularly check in with your Student Success Coach
- Meet with Learning Specialist or Student Wellness Office for additional support if needed
- Improve Cumulative GPA
- Earn no lower than B's/C+'s for your final grades
- Maintain an attendance rate of 80% or higher
- Minimize work conflicts as needed
- Minimize Outside/Family Issues as needed
- Follow the goals you outlined in your appeal letter

With your Student Success Coach please determine the necessary GPA and Completion Rate you must achieve to make satisfactory academic progress.
