About Franklin Cummings Tech's Afternoon Renewable Energy Bootcamp

Students will meet virtually and in-person seven weeks over the summer for six hours a week. Using virtual reality software and hands-on activities, this bootcamp introduces students to an overview of present and future energy needs, and choices for establishing an alternative energy economy.

The topics of this course provide a broad understanding of major renewable energy systems focused on solar, wind, and geothermal energy.

Students will learn topics including but not limited to:

- Gain a broad understanding of the components, techniques, and operation methodologies of various renewable energy systems.
- Ascertain knowledge of basic electrical theory that is required to understand any renewable energy source that generates electricity.
- Understand the basic concepts and factors that affect the generation, storage, and distribution of power generation through renewable energy resources.
- Gain skills in assessing the power generation capabilities of renewable energy systems.
- Demonstrate the skills to calculate and estimate the power generation levels in various environments.
